The IUGS is the world's largest and most prestigious geological organization, dedicated to advancing Earth sciences for the benefit of society. Through YoRI, we are building a global network of **young communicators and advocates** who report on geoscience, sustainability, and climate issues that matter most to their communities.

# WHO CAN APPLY?

Applicants should belong to one of the following fields:

- Earth Sciences
- Journalism
- Environmental Advocacy

And must meet one of the following academic requirements:

- Currently enrolled at a university
- Undergraduate degree obtained within the last 8 years
- Master's degree obtained within the last 5 years
- Doctoral degree obtained within the last 3 years
- Currently pursuing a postdoctoral fellowship

#### **CONTRIBUTION FORMAT**

As a Young Reporter, you will contribute by producing:

- Short videos (max. 4 minutes) reporting on climate change, geoscientific hazards, or sustainability challenges in your region (see format's description on our website)
- **Interviews** with authorities, scientists, and communities about their views on any of the 8 categories (see below for more information).
- Written reports highlighting key issues to be published on IUGS platforms (see format's description on our website).

### **REPORTING CATEGORIES**

All contributions will be classified under **8 categories** to ensure visibility and impact:

- 1. Climate Change and Geosciences
- 2. Geoscientific Hazards
- 3. Natural Resources for Sustainability
- 4. Environmental Geology
- 5. Geotechnology and Scientific Advancements
- 6. Geology, Development, and Culture
- 7. Activism
- 8. Propose Your Own!
